At about 2:30pm, everybody arrived the Conoil facility, to witness the physical launch of the project. A truck loaded with DPK with registration number XA 263 – NSR was used for the launch and it took off for Kano after the ceremony.

Using the RFID (Radio Frequency Identification Device) equipment, the Executive Secretary with the help of the Deputy Manager IT Mr. Lasisi, PEF(M)B depot representative Mr. Olaore showed and demonstrated to the stakeholders and guest present how the RFID device was used.

Speaking after the successful launching, Mrs. Kasali said with the electronic processing system in place, the presentation of fake meter tickets to the Board will be significantly reduced if not totally eliminated because the system will capture transaction from the loading depot as demonstrated by her and the team.

With Project Aquila, only transactions that are confirmed by the system that the trucks arrived with will be paid. Aquila will rely on information pulled from sales/loading data from the seller's IT system for confirmation of sales taking place.

She said for now, Aquila will be effective only in Conoil Plc but from October 4th to December 31st 2011, all other marketers will be using the electronic system concurrently with the manual system of processing bridging claims.

Mrs. Sharon Kasali thanked all the invited guest for their support and asked for their hand in partnership for progress. She particularly appreciated the Managing Director of Conoil Plc Mr. John Vasikaran for the effort he put in place to ensure the success of the launching in Conoil facility.

The event came to an end with assurances of cooperation from all stakeholders present particularly NARTO. ■

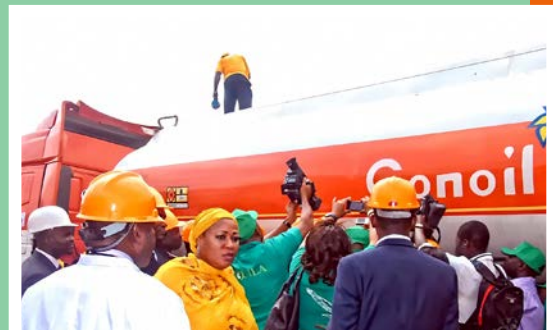
